- Includes title, authors, contact details and main findings of your research, as well as tables, figures and graphs where necessary.
- File format: PDF (.pdf)
- Size in pixel: 1080 width x 1536 height – portrait orientation
- Size in cm: 38,1 width x 54,2 height – portrait orientation
- Font size: ≥16

- Maximum 5 minutes, preferably **3 minutes**.
- **Please avoid sending us audio files.**
- File format: avi/wmv/mp4/mov
- Suggestions:
 - Do practice recordings beforehand, even in front of people in order to receive some feedback.
 - We would recommend that, if it is possible, you find a quiet room to avoid external noises disturbing the webinar.
 - It would be good to have a neutral background.
 - If you have an external microphone or headset, please feel free to use it.
 - In order to look your best, it would be good to avoid any bright light source (i.e. window) coming from behind you.
