





WHY BUENOS AIRES?

CONNECTED WITH THE WORLD

From its convenient location in South America, Buenos Aires is connected with the main cities of the region and the world. Its two international airports, which receive over 700 international flights per week, allow travelers to reach San Pablo and Santiago de Chile in two hours and Río de Janeiro in three hours, positioning Buenos Aires as a strategic location both regionally and internationally.

CULTURAL CAPITAL OF TANGO

Buenos Aires is the cradle of the tango, which was declared part of humanity's intangible cultural heritage by UNESCO in 2013. The magic of its melodies can be felt in every corner of local neighborhoods La Boca, San Telmo, Abasto, Boedo and Almagro, capturing the hearts of visiting tourists from around the world. Tango classes, live shows and the "Buenos Aires Tango Festival and World Championship" are just a few of the options to experience the 2x4 rhythm firsthand.

SUITABLE FOR ALL AUDIENCES

The city offers activities for every taste and budget: accommodation in hostels or luxury hotels, catamaran excursions on the Río de la plata (the widest river in the world), free open-air shows and gastronomic options that range from gourmet restaurants to street food carts.

HOST OF INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

The city is host to international events throughout the year. Concerts, operas, ballets, sporting events, festivals and big fairs, in addition to hundreds of congresses and thematic conventions, of the likes of Oil&Gas, Automechanika and ICCA Congress, for example. Tourists from all over the world come to enjoy Lollapalooza, the International Book Fair, the ATP of Buenos Aires and the Argentine Polo Championship, among others.

A HUB FOR CREATIVITY

Buenos Aires—a creative capital—has captured everyone's attention for locally produced design, art and content. In 2005, UNESCO declared Buenos Aires a city of design as part of its Creative Cities Network. There are several creative districts (Audiovisual, Arts, Technology and Design) where the production of creative contents and services are concentrated.

A CITY THAT NEVER SLEEPS

Whether by bus, on foot or a bicycle, there are many ways to enjoy the different tourism circuits, museums, art galleries, historic monuments, shopping malls and open-air fairs. At night, the lights of bars and restaurants come on to illuminate an unforgettable selection of dining and entertainment options.

Buenos Aires is internationally recognized for the academic level of its public and private institutions, and its experience in research & development. Each year, students from around the world come to study. With 36 universities, 29 of them private, the city boasts renowned professionals and appropriate facilities for national and international conferences.

Its parks and green spaces invite you to enjoy outdoors alone or with others. Public squares with rose gardens and lakes, the Botanical Garden, the Japanese Garden, the flower park, Thays Park, Tres de Febrero Park and Ecological Reserve are some of the options to spend an afternoon relaxing outdoors, surrounded by nature.







ITINERARIES FOR TRAVEL TRADE –LEISURE VISITORS & GROUPS

Make the most of your visit to Buenos Aires with these itineraries, which combine small samples of the heritage and charm that make the city so unique.



Multicultural Buenos Aires

Different communities have left their mark on the city, and their presence continues to be felt. Start out shopping in the Jewish quarter - the area known as Once - then find some tranquility in the **Japanese Garden** in the neighborhood of **Palermo** (also a good option for trying some Japanese food). In the afternoon, head to **La Boca** the portside neighborhood that became home to many Italian immigrants at the start of the 20th century. In the centre of the city, the past influence of Spain can be felt strongly on **Avenida de Mayo**, while a good option for dinner is to sample French cuisine on Avenida Alvear. An itinerary for a second day in town could take you to the market in Liniers, popular with the city's different Latin American communities, lunch in the Korean neighborhood in **Flores**, and an afternoon exploring the Middle Eastern influence in Palermo. And to round off such a multicultural tour, what better way than with a beer at one of the city's several Irish pubs.



The City's Secrets

Discover stories that few people know, from the hidden side of the obelisk to the curiosities of the Avenida de Mayo. It's worth a detour to visit **Galería Güemes**, where the eccentric writer Antoine de Saint Exupéry lived for a time, and to discover the underground tunnels of the city's historic quarter, as well as the city's oldest pharmacy. Close to here, you'll find **Parque Lezama**, a large park that belonged to a powerful local family. After that, you can move on to **Puerto Madero**, notable for its museum ships and famous sculpture. In the afternoon, visit **Recoleta Cemetery**, home to some of the city's darkest and most macabre secrets, then finally **the city's Chinatown**, founded by the city's Taiwanese community.



Architectural itineraries

The **city's eclecticism** is reflected in its streets with their mix of architectural influences. From hospitals to monuments, residential blocks and historic buildings, the variety of styles ranges from colonial dwellings to neogothic and neoclassical universities. Over the years, different movements had their moments, which remain reflected in the city today. You'll find Belle Époque in **Avenida Alvear** and traces of Art Nouveau in Avenida Rivadavia. There are also important rationalist buildings and even an "English" neighborhood with British influences.

BUENOS AIRES WITH LIMITED TIME



24 HOURS

Begin your day in San Nicolás, visiting the Plaza de Mayo and the Obelisk. Next, head over to San Telmo and then to La Boca for lunch. After lunch, hop onto one of the tourist buses and head over to Puerto Madero. Spend the late afternoon strolling through the elegant neighborhood of Recoleta and end your day in Palermo.



48 HOURS

On the second day, visit some of the traditional porteño neighborhoods, like Belgrano or Palermo. Have lunch in a traditional bodega; during the afternoon, walk along Corrientes Avenue and Florida Street, and visit one of the notable bars. That night, hit the dance floor to the 2/4 rhythm of tango at a tango cultural center or one of the city's many milongas.

GREEN SPACES

Buenos Aires offers many large expanses of green spaces and multiple outdoor experiences to enjoy, from biking to bird watching.

Parque tres de febrero

The park, popularly known as the woods of Palermo, is known for its forested areas, artificial lakes and rose garden. With over 400 hectares, it is the most popular green space in the city, enjoyed by everyone.

Parque Thays

This green space of approximately 4500 m2 was named after French landscape architect Carlos Thays. Within the park, there are many artistic works on display, including the United Nations statue by sculptor Marta Minujín; Masculine Torso, by Colombia artist Fernando Botero; Pro National Culture monument by the Italian sculptor Alejo Afani; and “The Tree,” by the artist Néstor Basterretxea.

Jardín Japonés

This garden was built by the Japanese community and inaugurated in 1967 on occasion of a state visit to Argentina by then-Crown Prince Akihito and Princess Michiko of Japan. In addition to its garden, it has a cultural activities center, a restaurant, a nursery, and a gift shop. Admission is charged and the proceeds go to the upkeep of the cultural center and grounds.



Jardín Botánico

The gardens offer a nice place for a walk or just to sit and relax. On its seven hectares, there are around 6,000 plant species, a botany library, three distinct landscape gardening styles (French, Roman and Oriental), a herbarium and five greenhouses, a large collection of sculptures and a English-style manor house for art exhibitions and workshops.

Parque Deportivo Costanera Norte

Located in Saint Tropez Park along Costanera Norte, this is one of the meeting points for fans of extreme sports, such as skateboarding, longboard, bowl skating, flatland skating, inline slalom, mountain biking, bicipolo and La Palestra (rock climbing). Built by the city government, the park has an outdoor fitness circuit, a park for events and concerts, and LED lighting system powered by solar energy.



Costanera Sur Ecological Reserve

Reserva ecológica


Located between Puerto Madero and the banks of the Rio de la Plata, this is the city's first protected area. On these 360 hectares of green space, visitors can enjoy its lagoons and marshes, forests of alder trees and pampas grass.

ENTERTAINMENT AND LEISURE

COMMERCIAL THEATERS

Corrientes Avenue, near the Obelisk, is the starting point of this tour. These theaters offer spectators a wide selection of live entertainment from musicals and tango shows, revues and local adaptations of international works. Among the most important theaters are the Lola Membrives, National, Astral, La Plaza, Metropolitan and Ópera.



Teatro Nacional Cervantes

CORRIENTES AVENUE

Along this avenue is the largest number of bookstores, theaters, pizzerias and cafes in the city.

Nicknamed "the street that never sleeps" for its vibrant nightlife, it witnessed the golden age of tango. Its bars, theaters and cabarets brought together the great musicians of the thirties, forties and fifties. Book and music lovers will feel they've found paradise along this avenue. New and old copies of your favorite records and books can be purchased with options for every budget. It is ideal for an evening stroll as stores close around 10pm.

NOTABLE BARS

There are bars that because of their antiquity, architecture or local significance, are considered "notable" and officially form part of the city's cultural heritage. Conversing with someone over a café "cortado" (a small coffee with a dash of milk) is a typical porteño ritual.

GASTRONOMIC TOURS



Puerto Madero

Puerto Madero is one of the most important gastronomic centers of the city. All along the main street Alicia Moreau de Justo, in the old docks of the port of Buenos Aires, there are well-known grills, serving up Argentine barbecue as well as many international restaurants.



Palermo Soho

Here contemporary dining options coexist with traditional bodegones and grills that persist from days gone past, once lived by this residential neighborhood.

Palermo Hollywood

Here visitors will find wide choice of bistros offering fusion, signature and international cuisine. Although more dispersed than its sister neighborhood on the other side of the railway tracks, it is worth exploring.

¿PALERMO VIEJO, SOHO OR HOLLYWOOD?

Note that the Palermo Soho and Palermo Hollywood are relatively new designations that still can cause confusion. They are subdivisions of what was traditionally Palermo Viejo.

Las Cañitas

Near the Argentine Polo Club and its fields, along Báez and surrounding streets, there are several restaurants and bars that form a thriving gastronomic center and nightspot.

Barrio Chino

Along Arribeños Street and surrounding streets, there are numerous Asian restaurants and markets. Another wave of more recent immigrants has brought another traditional cuisine to the neighborhood: Peruvian food.



Shopping mall specialized in design and decoration.


Patio Bullrich

San Martín, ave. Córdoba, Florida and Via-monte It is one of the main shopping centers of the city, worth visiting for its magnificent dome decorated with murals of outstanding Argentine painters: Antonio Berni, Lino Enea Spilimbergo, Demetrio Urruchúa and Juan Carlos Castagnino.

Located in the neighborhood Saavedra, this shopping center reformulates the mall concept. It offers outdoor green spaces and terraces.

Alto Palermo

Ave. Santa Fe 3253

At this traditional shopping mall in the Palermo neighborhood, you can find the best-known brands. It has a large food court and underground parking.

Paseo Alcorta

Salguero 3172

Another one of the most important shopping centers, this mall combines mass consumer brands and exclusive designers. It has a food court and a playground for children.

Distrito Arcos Premium Outlet

Paraguay 4979

Open-air shopping complex recently opened in the fully renovated buildings of the old railway facilities. It combines upscale outlets of leading brands and outdoor dining.

El Solar de la Abadía

Ave. Luis María Campos 940

This shopping mall with its large variety of brands is located in a fully renovated, former dry ice factory.

OPEN-AIR SHOPPING

Between the avenues of Corrientes, Rivadavia and Pueyrredón, and Pasteur Street It is one of the larger open-air shopping districts in the city, where Argentines from around the country come to buy fabric, clothing, party favors and other garment industry wares. Shoppers can find very low prices, but most businesses are dedicated to wholesale.

Calle Florida

From Diagonal Norte to Marcelo T. de Alvear, Retiro This long pedestrian street is lined with shops aimed at tourists. Here visitors will find leather garments, sweaters, souvenirs and other typical Argentine products.

Plaza Intendente Alvear Fair

Ave. Pueyrredón 2500

A craft fair open on weekends and holidays. This park is popularly known as Plaza Francia.

Avenida Alvear

The most elegant avenue in the area, this is where the luxury brands and art galleries are concentrated.



Santa Fe Avenue

From Cerrito to Ave. Sarmiento Here visitors will find the greatest variety of clothing stores, footwear, bazaars and bookstores.

Design Circuit in Palermo Viejo

Between Córdoba, Julián Álvarez, Guatemala and Godoy Cruz With more than 120 stores, Palermo Viejo is the most creative part of the city of Buenos Aires chosen by independent designers, trendsetters, artists and the most recognized brands of fashion and decoration.

Plaza Cortázar Crafts Fair

Jorge Luis Borges and Honduras, In the square and in the bars around it, artisans and independent designers offer their unique wares at very reasonable prices.

Aguirre Outlets

Aguirre 600 to 900, Gurruchaga 700 to 900 and Loyola 500 to 700

Along these city blocks is the widest selection of discount shops for designer clothing, shoes and accessories from leading brands with a selection from prior seasons and some items from their newest collections.

Feria de Plaza Dorrego

Ave. Dorrego and Niceto Vega

This large warehouse contains all kinds of novelties and treasures: furniture, paintings, sculptures, marble, bronze, glass, stones, jewelry, silverware, china, music, instruments, clothing, etc. Finds include antique furniture, artwork and objects from every period and style.



Avenida Cabildo

TRANSPORT



Avenida Figueroa Alcorta

There are several ways to get around this great city. For public transport, you will need to get yourself a rechargeable SUBE travel card.



BICYCLE

The city offers an economical, healthy and environmentally-friendly way to get around. EcoBici, the city's automated bike-share system, allows you to use a bike for free for up to an hour on weekdays, and up to two hours on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays. CITY BUSES

There are more than 180 bus lines running to every neighborhood of the city. Their routes are numbered. They operate 365 days a year, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



METROBUS

This newest transport system offered by the city ensures people can travel better and arrive at their destinations on time, more comfortably and efficiently. Information and routes are available at buenosaires.gov.ar/metrobus



SUBWAY

Six subway lines run under the city: A, B, C, D, E, H. Passengers can pay for each journey using a SUBE travel card. The tariff is fixed for journeys on all six lines. Services run Monday to Saturday from 6:00am-10:00pm, and on Sundays and holidays from 8:00am-10:00pm. Some lines operate slightly longer hours.



TRAINS

The suburban rail network is a good alternative for visiting tourist areas outside the city limits or for travelling to the more remote areas of the city. There are four terminal stations located throughout Buenos Aires that serve different routes:

- Retiro Station: trains to/from the north of Greater Buenos Aires and neighborhoods like Belgrano, Núñez, Villa Urquiza, Villa Devoto, etc.
- Constitución Station: trains to/from the south of Greater Buenos Aires.
- Once Station: trains to/from the west of Greater Buenos Aires and neighborhoods like Caballito, Flores and Liniers.
- Federico Lacroze Station: trains to/from the northeast of Greater Buenos Aires.



TAXIS

Taxis are painted black and yellow. They can be hailed off the street or requested over the phone. The cost of the trip is calculated based on the distance and time. The rate, expressed in Argentine pesos, will appear on a screen visible to the passenger. From 10:00pm to 6:00am, an evening rate of 20% higher than the daytime rate applies.
