## Highlights

- 1. The responsible microorganisms for glue Blackening were isolated
- 2. Two strains were assigned as Microbacterium oxydans sp and Alcaligenes faecalis sp
- 3. It is the first report of vinyle glue alteration caused by *Microbacterium oxydans*
- 4. Triaryl butenes have an interesting conservative potential compared to a commercial biocide
- 5. The biocide has to be water soluble in order to preserve more adequately the microbiological stability of the glue.
