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INTRODUCTION & AIM

WHY A NEW MODEL?

- Current care systems often focus on symptom reduction rather than meaningful life outcomes
- Fragmented services lead to loss of coherence in personal life projects
- There is a need for models that integrate values, autonomy, and coordinated support systems

AIM

- To present the ACIP model as a values-based and person-centered framework
- To integrate contextual behavioral science and social care practices
- To provide a structured methodology for supporting life projects

CONCEPTUAL FOUNDATIONS

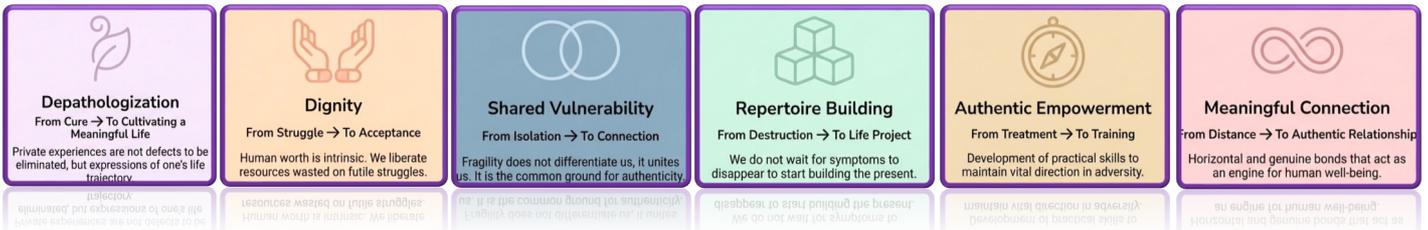
- Person-Centered Care: focus on individual autonomy and dignity
- Recovery Model: emphasis on meaningful life beyond symptoms
- Contextual Behavioral Science: behavior guided by values and context
- Relational Frame Theory: values as motivational drivers of action

So, what is the ACIP Model?

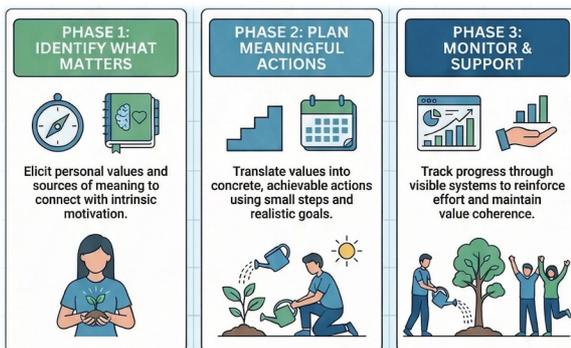
ACIP is a contextual-functional care model that organizes support around **what is important** to the person

- ✓ Moves from needs-based care to values-based care
- ✓ Connects daily actions with long-term life meaning
- ✓ Aligns services, professionals, and interventions with the life project

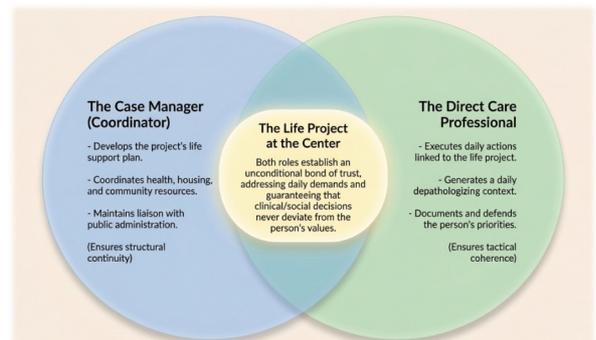

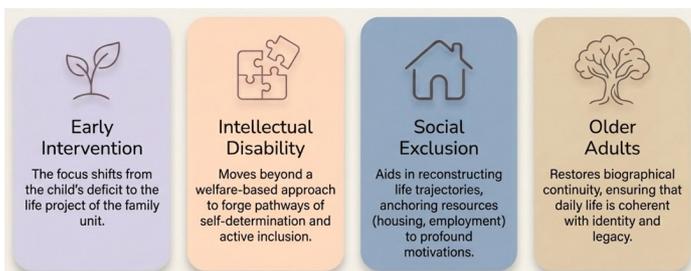
